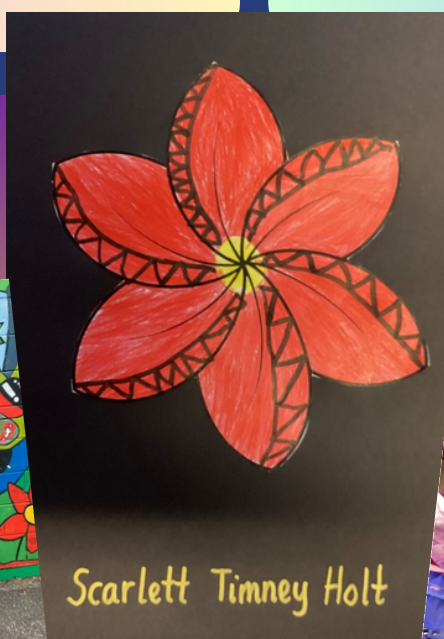

SCHOOL CARPARK

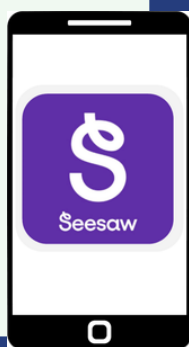
For the safety of the students, the carpark is for staff only. Cars in the school grounds create a possible hazard for children, and their safety must surely be a major concern.
